Welcome to the Sixth Form – Transition program

Dear Parent/Carer,

Transition to Sixth Form - Enclosed are details about the 'Transition to Sixth Form' program which will run at school over three days, Tuesday 22nd to Thursday 24th June.

Your son/daughter should arrive at the Merlin Theatre for a 10.00am start on Tuesday 22nd June.

We have already contacted all the students who needed to amend their subject choices because of timetabling or other issues. The subjects highlighted on the enclosed timetable are therefore confirmed provisional course choices.

Timetable Within this pack is an individual timetable for your son/daughter. The sessions they should attend are highlighted. They will have a welcome talk from Mrs Reynolds and myself in the Merlin Theatre, then 2 transition teaching sessions for each of their subject choices over the 3-day transition program. Students will collect transition work to complete over the Summer which will help them prepare for their Post 16 studies.



Those joining Sixth Form from other schools will have a Frome College familiarisation session with Miss Marshall (Deputy Head of Sixth Form) or myself.



Catering The café in the Sixth Form Common Room will be open during morning breaks and lunchtimes for the purchase of drinks and take-away style food – payment by ParentPay or debit cards only. Students are welcome to bring their own food if preferred. There will be a communal BBQ on Thursday.
